

**TENDER FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF

Part I – General information

1. Eligibility Criteria

The Bidding is open to all qualified Bidder who fully meet the following qualifying requirements: -

1. The bidder should be an ISO Certified OEM (Original Equipment Manufacturer) or their Authorized dealer /partner. In case of authorized dealer /partner, a letter of authorization from original manufacturer must be furnished. (Submit self-attested documents)
2. The bidder should have executed orders for supply of IT Products/ Language Lab or similar items in Govt. (State/ Central), PSUs /Universities during last 03 (three) years. (Submit self- attested document)
3. The bidder should have an annual turnover of not less than one crore in the last three financial years and must submit an attested photocopy of the audited Trial balance &/ or P&L account of last three years as a proof of stated annual turnover.
4. Bidder should have local office & service support in Jharkhand. (Submit self- attested documents)
5. Bidder must submit a copy of PAN Card and copy of valid GST Registration
6. Bidder must not have been blacklisted by any PSU's/ Central or State Government /University /Court of Law. (Submit Affidavit)
7. The manufacturer must have the experience and expertise in undertaking major projects of installing the similar brand software with government organizations with multiple locations in India and abroad.
8. The bidder must quote all items of requirement list & must have capability of executing entire work on Turnkey Basis (Tender will be evaluated on turnkey basis only).

(Technical bid of only those vendors will be opened who have submitted the proper Tender fee and EMD as asked for)

- (iv) **Tender Conditions Acceptance Certificate.** The bidder shall certify for acceptance of all the tender conditions of the online Tender and furnish a certificate as per Appx A. The certificate duly signed shall be submitted In case of any deviations, the bid shall be rejected. If the certificate is signed by legally authorised signatory, a copy of the authorization letter be enclosed/ uploaded.
- (v) Clause by clause Technical compliance of specifications certificates mentioned in Part II.

(3) Sealed Cover -III (Financial Bid (as per format Annexure VI)

All three Covers (bids) will be placed in sealed Cover , duly sealed, mentioning Tender No and Due date & Time

The Bid should be submitted by the bidder duly signed and stamped by the legal owner of the firm or the person authorised by him to do so.

4. **Time and date for opening of Bids:** 08.07.2021 at 12.30hrs.

If due to any exigency, the due date for opening of the Bids is declared a closed holiday, the Bids will be opened on the next working day at the same time or on any other day/time, as intimated by the University

For any delay in submission of bid due to any reason University will not be responsible
No post-bid clarification on the initiative of the bidder will be entertained.

5. **Place of submission and opening of the Bids:**

Office of C. C. D. C., Ranchi University, Ranchi.

The Bidders may depute their representatives, duly authorized in writing, to attend the opening of Bids on the due date and time. This event will not be postponed due to non-presence of any of the bidder / representative.

6. **Opening of Bids**

Bids will be opened as per critical date sheet mentioned in this tender document

Bid 1 (Tender Fee and EMD bid) will be opened (Technical bid of only those vendors will be opened who have submitted the proper Tender fee and EMD as asked for)

Bid 2 (Technical Bid)

The evaluation of technical Bid will be carried out by authorized committee

Bid 3 (Financial Bids) of only those Bidders whose technical bids meet all the stipulated Technical requirements shall be opened. The date of opening will be intimated to the Bidders through via phone /email /fax

7. **Clarification regarding contents of the TENDER:** A prospective bidder who requires clarification regarding the contents of the bidding documents shall notify to the University in writing about the clarifications sought not later than 10(ten) days prior to the date of opening of the Bids.
8. **Rejection of Bids:** Canvassing by the Bidder in any form, unsolicited letter and post-tender correction may invoke summary rejection with forfeiture of EMD. Conditional Bids will not be accepted.
9. **Validity of Bids:** The Bids should remain valid till **90 Days** from the date of opening of tenders from the last date of submission of the Bids.
10. **EMD:** Bidders are required to submit Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) for amount of **Rs.70,000/- (Rupees Seventy Thousand only)** along with the bids. The EMD may be submitted in the form of an Account Payee Demand Draft, Fixed Deposit Receipt duly pledged, Banker's Cheque or Bank Guarantee from any of the public sector banks Demand draft & Banker's cheque should be drawn in favor of "**The Registrar, Ranchi University, Ranchi**". EMD is to remain valid for a period three months. EMD of the unsuccessful bidders will be returned to them at the earliest after expiry of the final bid validity and latest on or before the 30th day after the award of the contract. The Bid Security of the successful bidder would be returned, without any interest whatsoever, after the receipt of Performance Security from them as called for in the contract. EMD is not required to be submitted by those Bidders who are exempted by government such as Small Industries Corporation (SIC), MSME. The bidder is required to attach the copy of proof for exemption of

EMD (SSI,SIC or MSME certificate) with their technical offer. The EMD will be forfeited if the bidder withdraws or amends impairs or derogates from the tender in any respect within the validity period of their tender.

11. **Manner for obtaining the Tender Set.** The tender documents are available for download at **<http://ranchiuniversity.ac.in>**. The interested firm may download the documents and submit the same along with required tender fees.

Part II – Essential Details of Items/Services required

1. Bidders are required to furnish clause by compliance of specifications bringing out clearly the deviations from specification, if any. The Bidders are advised to submit the compliance statement in the following format along with Technical Bid: -

2. **Delivery Note:** Delivery should be within **eight weeks** from the date of Supply Order. Supply should be made at the address provided in the order. Room will be provided by the college where vendor must complete all installation work within maximum 12 weeks from the date of order.

Part III – Standard Conditions of Tender

The Bidder is required to give confirmation of their acceptance of the Standard Conditions of the Tender mentioned below which will automatically be considered as part of the Contract concluded with the successful Bidder (i.e. Seller in the Contract) as selected by the University. Failure to do so may result in rejection of the Bid submitted by the Bidder.

1. **Law:** The Contract shall be considered and made in accordance with the laws of the State of Jharkhand. The contract shall be governed by and interpreted in accordance with the laws of the State of Jharkhand.
2. **Effective Date of the Contract:** The contract shall come into effect on the date of signatures of both the parties on the contract (Effective Date) and shall remain valid until the completion of the obligations of the parties under the contract i.e. period of one year. The deliveries and supplies and performance of the services shall commence from the effective date of the contract.
3. **Arbitration:** All disputes or differences arising out of or in connection with the Contract shall be settled by bilateral discussions. Any dispute, disagreement or question arising out of or relating to the Contract or relating to construction or performance, which cannot be settled amicably, may be resolved through arbitration.
4. **Penalty for use of Undue influence:** The Seller undertakes that he has not given, offered or promised to give, directly or indirectly, any gift, consideration, reward, commission, fees, brokerage or inducement to any person in service of the University or otherwise in procuring the Contracts or forbearing to do or for having done or forborne to do any act in relation to the obtaining or execution of the present Contract or any other Contract with the University for showing or forbearing to show favour or disfavour to any person in relation to the present Contract or any other Contract with the University. Any breach of the aforesaid undertaking by the Seller or any one employed by him or acting on his behalf (whether with or without the knowledge of the Seller) or the commission of any offers by the Seller or anyone employed by him or acting on his behalf, as defined in Chapter IX of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 or the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1986 or any other Act enacted for the prevention of corruption shall entitle the University to cancel the contract and recover from the Seller the amount of any loss arising from such cancellation. A decision of the University or its nominee to the effect that a breach of the undertaking had been committed shall be final and binding on the Seller. Giving or offering of any gift, bribe or inducement or any attempt at any such act on behalf of the Seller towards any officer/employee of the University or to any other person in a position to influence any officer/employee of the University for showing any favour in relation to this or any other contract, shall render the Seller to such liability/ penalty as the University may deem proper, including but not limited to termination of the contract, imposition of penal damages, forfeiture of the Bank Guarantee and refund of the amounts paid by the University.
5. **Non-disclosure of Contract documents:** Except with the written consent of the University/ Seller, other party shall not disclose the contract or any provision, specification, plan, design, pattern, sample or information thereof to any third party.
6. **Liquidated Damages:** In the event of the Seller's failure to submit the Bonds, Guarantees and Documents, supply the manpower, training, etc as specified in this contract, the University may, at its discretion, withhold any payment until the completion of the contract. The University may also deduct from the Seller as agreed, liquidated damages to the sum of 0.5% of the contract price of the

delayed/undelivered services mentioned above for every week of delay or part of a week, subject to the maximum value of the Liquidated Damages being not higher than 10% of the value of delayed services.

7. **Termination of Contract:** The University shall have the right to terminate this Contract in part or in full in any of the following cases: -
 - (a) If proper discipline and conduct is not maintained.
 - (b) If the service is not satisfactory.
 - (c) If any employee is found consuming alcohol or drugs or intoxicated in the campus/ on duty.
8. **Notices:** Any notice required or permitted by the contract shall be written in the English language and may be delivered personally or may be sent by e-mail or registered pre-paid mail/airmail, addressed to the last known address of the party to whom it is sent.
9. **Transfer and Sub-letting:** The Seller has no right to give, bargain, sell, assign or sublet or otherwise dispose of the Contract or any part thereof, as well as to give or to let a third party take benefit or advantage of the present Contract or any part thereof.
10. **Amendments:** No provision of present Contract shall be changed or modified in any way (including this provision) either in whole or in part except by an instrument in writing made after the date of this Contract and signed on behalf of both the parties and which expressly states to amend the present Contract.

Part IV – Special Conditions of Tender

The Bidder is required to give confirmation of their acceptance of Special Conditions of the Tender mentioned below which will automatically be considered as part of the Contract concluded with the successful Bidder (i.e. Seller in the Contract) as selected by the University. Failure to do so may result in rejection of Bid submitted by the Bidder.

1. **Performance Guarantee :** The Bidder will be required to furnish a Performance Guarantee by way of Bank Guarantee through a public sector bank for a sum equal to 10% of the contract value within 30 days of receipt of the confirmed order. Performance Bank Guarantee should be valid up to 30 days beyond the date of contract period.
2. **Option Clause:** The contract will have an Option Clause, wherein the University can exercise an option to procure an additional 50% of the original contracted quantity in accordance with the same terms & conditions of the present contract. This will be applicable within the currency of contract. The Bidder is to confirm the acceptance of the same for inclusion in the contract. It will be entirely the discretion of the University to exercise this option or not.
3. **Repeat Order Clause –** The contract will have a Repeat Order Clause, wherein the present contract may extend to another six months from the date of completion of this present contract, the cost, terms & conditions remaining the same. The Bidder is to confirm acceptance of this clause. It will be entirely at the discretion of the University to place the Repeat order or not.
4. **Tolerance Clause–** To take care of any change in the requirement during the period starting from issue of Tender till placement of the contract, The University reserves the right to 15 % plus/minus increase or decrease in the quantity of the required goods up to that limit without any change in the terms &

conditions and prices quoted by the Seller. While awarding the contract, the quantity ordered can be increased or decreased by the University within this tolerance limit.

5. **Payment Terms** - It will be mandatory for the Bidders to indicate their bank account numbers and other relevant e-payment details so that payments could be made through ECS/EFT mechanism instead of payment through cheques, wherever feasible. A copy of the model mandate form prescribed by RBI to be submitted by Bidders for receiving payments through ECS. 100% Payment will be made within 21 days of installation of Language lab at designated place.

6. **Advance Payments:** No advance payment will be made

7. **Force Majeure clause**

(a) Neither party shall bear responsibility for the complete or partial non-performance of any of its obligations (if the non-performance results from such Force Majeure circumstances as Flood, Fire, Earth Quake and other acts of God as well as War, Military operation, blockade, Acts or Actions of State Authorities or any other circumstances beyond the parties control that have arisen after the conclusion of the present contract.

(b) In such circumstances the time stipulated for the performance of an obligation under the present contract is extended correspondingly for the period of time of action of these circumstances and their consequences.

(c) The party for which it becomes impossible to meet obligations under this contract due to Force Majeure conditions, is to notify in written form the other party of the beginning and cessation of the above circumstances immediately, but in any case not later than 10 (Ten) days from the moment of their beginning.

(d) Certificate of a Chamber of Commerce (Commerce and Industry) or other competent authority or organization of the respective country shall be a sufficient proof of commencement and cessation of the above circumstances.

Part V – Evaluation Criteria & Price Bid issues

1. **Evaluation Criteria** - The broad guidelines for evaluation of Bids will be as follows: -

(a). Only those Bids will be evaluated which are found to be fulfilling all the eligibility and qualifying requirements of the Tender, both technically and Financially.

(b). The technical Bids submitted by the Bidders will be evaluated by the University with reference to the technical characteristics of the equipment as mentioned in the Tender. Additional information for technical evaluation as enclosed in Annexure I should be completely filled by tenderers. Tenderers with incomplete details in Annexure I are liable to be ignored. Tenderers mentioning rates in price format with technical bid are liable to be ignored. The compliance of Technical bids would be determined on the basis of the parameters like agreeing for technical specifications and other parameters as per Tender, and submission of EMD, tender fee, return of complete bid documents duly signed, registration / capacity verification prior to tender opening, agreeing for terms of delivery and quoting delivery period, agreeing for warranty clause & agreeing for PBG, payment terms etc. specified in the Tender. The Price Bids of only those Bidders will be opened whose Technical Bids would clear the technical evaluation.

(c). The Lowest Bid will be decided upon the lowest price quoted by the particular Bidder as per the Price Format given at Para 2 below. The ultimate cost to the University would be the deciding factor for ranking of Bids. As it is a turnkey project, **the final total cost will be taken into account, NOT the individual items.**

(d). If there is a discrepancy between the unit price and the total price that is obtained by multiplying the unit price and quantity, the unit price will prevail and the total price will be corrected. If there is a discrepancy between words and figures, the amount in words will prevail for calculation of price.

(e). The Lowest Acceptable Bid will be considered further for placement of contract / Supply Order after complete clarification as decided by the University. The University reserves the right to do Apportionment of Quantity, if it is convinced that Lowest Bidder is not in a position to supply full quantity in stipulated time.
