Workshop Overview

Theme: “PG Curriculum and Credit framework” (as per NEP 2020 recommendations)

Background: A major thrust is given in NEP 2020 with initiatives such as multidisciplinary education with multiple entry and exit (MEME) options, research at the undergraduate level, learning outcomes-based curriculum approach, etc. The postgraduate programmes help students to extend their knowledge of their chosen subject and prepare them for higher research studies. The advanced knowledge and specialized skills they gain in the PG programme are crucial to sustaining the journey of a student from the acquirer of knowledge to the creator of knowledge.

The re-structured degree programmes are promoted in both undergraduate and postgraduate education. In conformity with the restructured FYUGP, the policy mandates HEIs to have the flexibility to offer different designs of Master’s programmes. PG framework should be in sync with National Credit Framework (NCrF) for the creditization of all learning and assignments, accumulation, storage, transfer & redemption of credits, subject to assessment.

UGC has already released the structure of PG programmes in its “Draft Curriculum and Credit Framework for PG Programmes” which is a ready reference to initiate the preparation of PG Curriculum having various aspects as mentioned above.

Need and Objective: Ranchi University has adopted NEP 2020 FYUGP from the academic year 2022. Students opting exit after the Bachelor degree in 3 years will be seeking admission in 2-year PG programmes in the year 2025 and those completing the Four-year Bachelor Degree (Hons.) or Bachelor Degree (Hons. with Research) shall be seeking admission for 1-year PG programme in the year 2026. Hence, the need for this workshop on the curriculum and credit framework for PG programmes.
